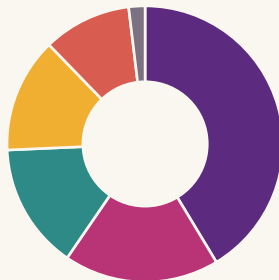
WE MADE THE \$1 MILLION MARK

The H100 Latina Giving Circle at Texas Women's Foundation was established in 2019 by the Hispanic 100 to further engage Latina women in philanthropy, and to expand resources for local organizations whose mission is to empower, educate and support Latinas and our community.

The Giving Circle is a committee of Hispanic 100, building on the organization's 30-year history of collective leadership and influence to drive meaningful change for Latina women and girls across DFW.

Since 2019, the Latina Giving Circle has awarded an incredible \$1,022,200 through 217 grants to North Texas nonprofits. This year alone, after reviewing a record 82 applications, we awarded \$136,200 through 22 grants.
